In a catastrophic disaster, government resources may not be available for days following the event. The Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) Program trains participants in disaster preparedness and basic emergency skills. Here's how individuals, neighborhood groups, businesses & organizations can participate in the Berkeley Citywide Emergency Exercise on Saturday, April 27:

## INDIVIDUALS

- Call out-of-area emergency contacts
- Review your emergency supplies
- Do an earthquake Hazard Hunt in your home
- Listen to emergency radio station 1610AM
- Know how to shut off your gas line
- Check your fire extinguishers

## NEIGHBORHOOD GROUPS

- Activate your CERT Command Post
- Practice conducting damage assessment
- Practice CERT fire safety skills

## BUSINESSES & ORGANIZATIONS

- Practice workplace evacuation plan
- Set up an info booth on emergency preparedness
- Have an employee meeting to discuss disaster plan
- Check your emergency supply kits
- Organize a CERT Team
