

## **Waterside Workshops**

- Our donation has funded weekly job training classes for 15 young adults over a 10-week period.

## **Go Green Initiative**

- We have provided four students the opportunity to participate in a scholarship program that encourages students to come up with ways to incorporate clean, renewable energy into communities, regardless of their field of study.

## **Siyaphambili Village**

- Our donation has helped Ndileka Xameni provide a home and healthy, hearty meals for 25 children in Langa, outside of Cape Town, South Africa.

## **The Bread Project**

- We provided the funds for fifteen trainees to receive certification in kitchen safety and sanitation.

## **Pogo Park**
