Berkeley's voter-approved Public Financing Program allows certified candidates for Mayor and City Council seats to receive a 6-to-1 match on qualifying contributions of up to \$50 from Berkeley residents (e.g. for a \$50 qualifying contribution, a participating candidate receives \$300 in public matching funds), to a maximum of \$43,000 for City Council candidates and \$129,000 for mayoral candidates..
