### TRACTS WITHIN URBANIZED AREA

- Equity Priority Communities
- Census Designated Urbanized Area

The Equity Priority Communities (tract geography) dataset is based upon eight demographic variables:

1. People of Color (70% threshold)
2. Low-Income (28% threshold)
3. Limited English Proficiency (12% threshold)
4. Seniors 75 Years and Over (8% threshold)
5. Zero-Vehicle Households (15% threshold)
6. Single Parent Families (18% threshold)
7. People with a Disability (12% threshold)
8. Rent-Burdened Households (14% threshold)

If a tract exceeds both threshold values for Low-Income and People of Color shares OR exceeds the threshold value for Low-Income AND also exceeds the threshold values for three or more variables (#3 to #8), it is an Equity Priority Community.
